Dear 5th Grade Families :)

What a busy week :) !

And . . . exciting news on the 5th grade class president and vice president . . . we are so proud of the 8 students who were interested in sharing their leadership skills to be class president and we heard some very well-delivered speeches. Dawson Batchelder was elected as President and Coleson Mott was elected as Vice-President. Two class representatives from each class will be elected this week.

In Writing, students worked on their final copies of either their "Most Unforgettable Event" or "A Time When They Needed Help." I am very anxious to read each one because they have worked very diligently on them all week.

In Social Studies, we learned about the five Intolerable Acts leading up to the American Revolution (The Boston Port Act, The Massachusetts Government Act, The Administration of Justice Act, Quartering Act and Quebec Act.) Their first government assessment has been placed in the Social Studies section of their binders and entered in TeacherEase.

In Reading, we worked on text-to-text connections and also took a "No Excuse Words" Spelling test. These are high-frequency words that they use in everyday writing and they have been using many of them for several years. Next week, we will continue with text-to-world connections and theme/moral.

Tracking sheets have been added to the Reading section of their binders to show their Lexile levels from the end of 4th grade and also from the recent NWEA test that we took at the beginning of this year. There is also a tracking sheet for their most current F&P reading level. The 5th grade end-of-year lexile range is 920-1010 and end-of-year F&P level should be U-V. A score will be entered in TeacherEase for these reading levels this week.
